With the help of many good friends and our daughter Julia, we made the basic move last Friday and are settling into the routine of the community here.

Well, at least I am. Don hasn't had a chance to get settled. Just three days after moving in, on Monday night, he ended up in the ER again and was admitted to Tuality Hospital with a bladder infection. It also seems that he still has not fully recovered from the earlier pneumonia.

In spite of this unexpected turn of events, I'm thankful to have been here at Cornell Estates instead of our own home. Staff from the facility helped me get Don out of the apartment and into the car to go to the ER. And this time I don't have to grab something to eat whenever I can because the meals are already prepared. Instead, I can concentrate on other essentials.

I don't know how long Don will be in the hospital. It is likely that he will need to be in rehab for a while after being discharged, but we are in a much better place to get all that coordinated. I still have a lot to do relative to our move, as well as preparation for the ACMI conference coming up at the end of May.
